ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE ELECTORAL PROVISIONS (REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE, 1961,  
(No. 10 of 1961.)

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE ELECTORAL PROVISIONS (REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE, 1961, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electoral Provisions (Registration) (Revocation) Order, 1963.
2. The Electoral Provisions (Registration) Order, 1963\*, is hereby revoked.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to explain the reasons for making it).

As a result of the publication on the 13th July, 1963, of the Electoral Provisions (Registration) Order, No. 52 of 1963, a person who reaches the age of 21 on the 1st August, 1963, will have less than the 17 days to which he is entitled by law within which to make his claim. The Order is therefore revoked to avoid this anomaly. It is proposed to make a new Order setting the qualifying date as the 1st September, 1963.
