ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1963,
(No. 7 of 1963)

UNDER REGULATION 31 OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1963 AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I DO HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Maintenance of Supplies) (Amendment) (No. 5) Order, 1963, and shall be construed and read with the Emergency Powers (Maintenance of Supplies) Order, 1963* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order and any Order amending the same.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended —

- (a) by the deletion therefrom of article 5 C;
- (b) by the deletion of the words “, salt, sugar and margarine” in paragraph (2) of article 6;
- (c) by the deletion of paragraph (5) of article 6; and
- (d) by the deletion therefrom of article 7.

3. The schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution for the words “canned meat and fish” therein of the word “sardines”; and
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of the following articles —

“Split peas	Pickled pork products
Salted and pickled fish	Pickled beef
Condensed milk	Edible oil
Evaporated milk	Margarine
Cooking butter	Matches”.
