### UNDER THE ACQUISTION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDI-NANCE AND THE ACQUISITION OF LAND (LAND SETTLE-MENT) ORDINANCE, 1957, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARA-GRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. Under section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Ordinance and section 3 of the Acquisition of Land (Land Settlement) Ordinance, 1957, the land settlement scheme at Plantation Anna Regina *cum annexis* is hereby declared to be a public work.

2. Under section 4 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Ordinance\* and by virtue of the application thereof in accordance with section 3 of the Acquisition of Land (Land Settlement) Ordinance, 1957, the Commissioner of Lands and Mines, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the parcel of iand set out in the schedule hereto for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of it for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

### SCHEDULE

Lot 4A, being a part of Lot 4 Plantation La Belle Alliance, situate on the Essequibo Coast in the County of Essequibo and Colony of British Guiana.

The tract commences at a wood paal G.M.F.R. planted N  $273^{\circ} 17' 48''$  tr. 1109.5 feet from the centre line of the Public Road and extends N  $273^{\circ}17' 48''$  tr. 148.27 feet thence N  $185^{\circ} 47' 48''$  tr. 308.9 feet thence N  $93^{\circ} 17' 48''$  tr. 148.27 feet, thence N  $5^{\circ} 47' 48''$  tr. 308.9 feet to the point of commencement, as shown on a plan by G. M. F. Rayman, Government Surveyor, dated 9th March, 1961, and recorded in the Department of Lands and Mines as Plan No. 9720.
