ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,

(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 3) Order, 1963, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1963, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended —
(a) by the insertion after item 001-01 of the following item —

“001-04 Poultry (live).”;

(b) by the deletion of the words “Rice, grain in the husk including polished and broken.” and “Rice, grain not in the husk” appearing respectively against item 042-01 and item 042-02, and the substitution therefor of the words “Rice, grain in the husk.” and “Rice, grain not in the husk, including polished and broken.” respectively;

(c) by the deletion of the words “Beans and peas, dry (excluding garbanzos and chick peas)” appearing against item 054-02 and the substitution therefor of the words “Blackeye peas.”;

(d) by the insertion in item 412-19 of the words and comma “sesame oil,” between the expressions “cohone oil,” and “sunflower oil”.

3. The second schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following items immediately after item 051-07 —

“061-01 Sugar, cane or beet, unrefined.”;

“061-02 Sugar, cane or beet, refined.”.
