BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Powers Order, 1963.

2. The Minister of Finance is hereby deputed to exercise on behalf of the Governor the powers specified in the first column of the schedule to this Order conferred on the Governor by the Ordinance mentioned in the second column of the said schedule, subject however, to the following conditions and qualifications. —

- (a) that the delegation of each power effected by this Order shall remain in force only until it is varied or revoked by the Governor;
- (b) that the exercise of any power delegated by this Order shall be subject to any direction, either general or particular, which the Governor may from time to time give in that respect.

SCHEDULE

Power delegated	Ordinance
1. To grant permission in writing to a retailer of methylated spirits to have in his possession a greater quantity of methylated spirits than fifty gallons, to permit the sale to a person for his use of more than five gallons of such spirits at a time, and to permit a person to keep more than five gallons of such spirits at a time.	The Spirits Ordinance, Chapter 319. (Paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section 78).

Power delegated**Ordinance**

2. To revoke at any time in his discretion a permission granted to a retailer of methylated spirits to have in his possession a greater quantity of methylated spirits than fifty gallons, a permission for the sale to a person for his use of more than five gallons of such spirits at a time, and a permission to keep more than five gallons of such spirits at a time.
