## ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955,  
(No. 30 of 1955).

UNDER SECTION 9(5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Vesting) (No. 4) Order, 1963.
2. The works described in the schedule hereto in the Canals Polder Drainage and Irrigation Area shall vest in and become the property of the Board.

## SCHEDULE

- (1) A watercourse with banks on either side extending northwards from the feeder canal north of the Centre Trench to a point midway between the Centre Trench and "A" Line on the reserve between North Section Government lands and Plantation Soesdyke, thence south-eastwards across Plantation Soesdyke to the eastern sideline of Plantation Soesdyke.
- (2) A drain on the eastern sideline of Plantation Soesdyke extending southwards from "A" Line trench to a point immediately south of south bank of watercourse described at (1) thence north-westwards and parallel to the south bank of above watercourse to the reserve between North Section Government lands and Plantation Soesdyke.
- (3) An irrigation intake at the junction of the feeder canal north of Centre Trench and the watercourse described at (1).
