GENERAL ORDER 33 — APPENDIX E

AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS GOVERNING ACTING APPOINTMENTS AND ACTING ALLOWANCES TO PUBLIC OFFICERS.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Officers (Acting Appointments and Acting Allowances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the Public Officers (Acting Appointments and Acting Allowances) Regulations, 1958, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any regulations amending the same.

2. The proviso to regulation 3 of the Principal Regulation is hereby amended in the following respects.—

(a) by the substitution of the following paragraph for paragraph (i) —

“(i) An officer who acts continuously for a period exceeding seven months in an office, the salary of which is not incremental, and the substantive holder of which has been granted leave which is governed, whether wholly or partly, by the leave regulations in force at the 31st December, 1961, shall be paid an acting allowance for such period exceeding seven months at a rate equal to the difference between the salary of the specified office and his substantive salary.”;

(b) by the renumbering of paragraphs (ii), (iii) and (iv) as paragraphs (iii), (iv) and (v) respectively; and

(c) by the insertion of the following paragraph as paragraph (ii) —

“(ii) An officer who acts continuously for a period exceeding four months in an office the salary of which is not incremental, in circumstances other than those described in paragraph (i) of this proviso shall be paid an acting allowance for such period exceeding four months at a rate equal to the difference between the salary of the specified office and his substantive salary.”

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st October, 1964.
