ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

(Chapter 51:02)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE BY SECTION 48 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Vilssengen Road and Extension of Irving Street) (One-way Streets) Order 1977. Citation.

2. Vehicles travelling on the roads specified in Column 1 of the schedule are prohibited from travelling in the respective directions specified in Column 2 thereof. Restrictions on use of streets.

SCHEDULE

Column 1

Vilssengen Road between Lamaha Street and Kitty Public Road

North.

That road, situate in the City of Georgetown, commonly regarded as the extension of Irving Street in a northerly direction from its intersection with Lamaha Street to its intersection with Carifesta Avenue, and being immediately west of, and parallel to, Vilssengen Road.

South.
