MADE UNDER

THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 71).

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Fraser (Transfer of Insurance Policy) Order, 1965.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the two policies of insurance in the sums of three thousand dollars and one thousand dollars effected on the life of WALTER OGLE FRASER with the Sun Life Company of Canada and the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company respectively, under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said WALTER OGLE FRASER and his wife ELMA DOROTHY and pay over to them the proceeds of such policies of insurance and any increases thereon.
