THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY AND
SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ORDINANCE, 1965

(No. 7 of 1965)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ORDINANCE, 1965, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE MINISTER OF FINANCE:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Allowances) (No. 2) Order, 1965, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1965.

2. In this Order —

“the Ordinance” means the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) Ordinance, 1965.*

3. The schedule to the Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition after item 7 of the following —

“8. The Speaker of the House of Assembly shall be paid an entertainment allowance of \$60 per month.

9. The Premier shall be paid a household allowance at a rate not exceeding \$1,248 per month for expenses in excess of \$100 per month actually incurred in the employment of domestic staff at and in the upkeep of any residence normally occupied by the Premier which is provided by the Government under section 3 of the Ordinance.”
