ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE
(Chapter 71).

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parsley (Transfer of Insurance Policies) Order, 1965.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the two policies of insurance in the sums of one thousand four hundred and eighty dollars and nine hundred and eighty six dollars effected on the life of CLIFFORD HUGH PARSLEY with the Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said CLIFFORD HUGH PARSLEY and his wife HENRIETTA PARSLEY and pay over to them the proceeds of such policies and any increases thereon.
