THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 71)

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE BY THE GOVERNOR'S DEPUTY:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Patoir (Transfer of Insurance Policies) Order, 1965.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the two policies of insurance in the sums of one thousand dollars each effected on the life of WILLIAM PIERCY PATOIR with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company and the Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society respectively under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said WILLIAM PIERCY PATOIR and his wife LILIAN PATOIR and pay over to them the proceeds of such policies and any increases thereon.
