THE PUBLIC AND JUDICIAL OFFICERS (REMUNERATION)  
ORDINANCE, 1962,

(No. 26 of 1962).

UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE PUBLIC AND JUDICIAL OFFICERS (REMUNERATION) ORDINANCE, 1962, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR FINANCE:—

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Public and Judicial Officers (Allowances) (Amendment) Order, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the Public and Judicial Officers (Allowances) Order, 1963, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any order amending the same.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 14th December, 1964.

2. Article 4 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "one hundred and twenty" for the word "ninety".

This Order amends the Public and Judicial Officers (Allowances) Order, 1963, to increase the chauffeur allowance payable to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.
