ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE
(Chapter 280)

UNDER SECTION 47 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 26 OF 1961, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR ACTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF —

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Georgetown) (One-Way Streets) Order, 1965.
2. (a) A vehicle shall not proceed in a westerly direction in or along the northern side of Hadfield Street from its junction with Winter Place to its junction with Camp Street.
(b) A vehicle shall not proceed in an easterly direction in or along the southern side of Hadfield Street from its junction with Camp Street to its junction with Winter Place.
3. This Order shall come into force on the first day of January, 1966.
