ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 191).

UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 9 OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Construction) (No. 2) Order, 1965.
2. The Board shall cause to be re-aligned and re-constructed the sea defence described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The sea defence dam extending from Plantation Windsor Castle to the Concrete Sluice at Plantation Lima Middlewalk, on the Essequibo Coast, in the Sea Defence District No. 1.
