UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1965, and shall be construed and read with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1963\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.
  - 2. The first Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby further amended:—
