THE TRADE ACT
(Cap. 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) (Ale, Beer and Stout) Order*, may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Ale, Beer and Stout) (Amendment) Order 1978.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended:-

Amendment of the Principal Order.

(a) by the substitution in Part A of the Schedule thereto, for the particulars specified in the second, third and fourth columns respectively thereto in relation to the articles, (Bass Ale, Banks Beer and Bass Stout), of the particulars specified in the second, third and fourth columns, respectively of Part A of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the same articles; and

(b) by the substitution in Part B of the Schedule thereto, for the particulars specified in the second, third and fourth columns respectively thereto in relation to the articles, (Bass Ale, Banks Beer and Bass Stout), of the particulars specified in the second, third and fourth columns, respectively of Part B of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the same articles.
