THE WAGES COUNCIL ACT

(Chapter 98:04)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 OF THE WAGES COUNCIL ACT I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Wages Council (Mechanical Transport Workers) Order, 1978. Citation
2. In this Order — Interpre-
tation
“motor vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads, and includes an articulated vehicle as defined in regulation 2 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations. Cap. 51:02
“trailer” means a vehicle of any kind used on a road without independent motive power intended to be drawn by a motor vehicle.
3. There is hereby established in respect of workers to whom this Order applies and their employers, a Wages Council to be known as the Wages Council for Mechanical Transport Workers. Establish-

4. This Order applies to all workers employed by any person wholly or mainly in any of the following capacities in connection with a motor vehicle:— Applica-
tion
of Order
 - (a) driver of a motor vehicle;
 - (b) conductor;
 - (c) porter; and
 - (d) delivery man.
