THE MARITIME BOUNDARIES ACT 1977

(No. 10 of 1977)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
SECTION 25 OF THE MARITIME BOUNDARIES ACT 1977, THE
FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE:—

This Order may be cited as the Fishing Boats (St. Lucia) Designation
Order 1978 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 4th
March, 1978.

St. Lucia is hereby designated for the purpose of section 25(1) of the
Act.

(1) The area in which a fishing boat registered in St. Lucia may fish in
the fishery zone shall be that extending —

- shorewards to the 12 fathoms isobath; and
- seawards to the 19 fathoms isobath.

(2) The description of fish for which such fishing boat may fish is
"fin-fish".
