THE TRADE ACT

(Cap. 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 53) Order 1978. Citation.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects— Amendment of the Principal Order.

- (a) by the substitution in Clause 4 (1) (b) thereof, of the words "\$30.30" for the words "\$27.11" appearing therein; and
- (a) by the substitution in Part A of the Fourth Schedule thereto, for the particulars specified in the respective columns of that Schedule in relation to the article numbered 3 (Flour), of the particulars specified in the respective columns of Part A of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the said article; and
- (c) by the substitution in Part B of the Fourth Schedule thereto, for the particulars specified in the respective columns of that Schedule in relation to the article numbered 3 (Flour) of the particulars specified in the respective columns of Part B of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the said article.
