THE MARITIME BOUNDARIES ACT 1977

(No. 10 of 1977)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER  
BY SECTION 25(1) OF THE MARITIME BOUNDARIES ACT, 1977  
THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Fishing Boats (Barbados) Designation Order 1978, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 2nd October, 1978.

Citation and commencement

2. Barbados is hereby designated for the purposes of section 25(1).

Designation of country for purposes of section 25 of the Act.

3. A fishing boat registered in Barbados may, at any time during the period commencing:—

Area and season for fishing

- (a) on 1st March and ending on 31st October, engage in shrimping in that area of the fishery zone extending — shorewards to the 19 fathoms isobath; and
- (b) on 1st November and ending on the last day in February, engage in fin fishing in that area of the fishery zone extending shorewards to the 12 fathoms isobath.

(2) The description of the fish for which any such fishing boat may fish is shrimp of the species *Penaeus duorarum notialis* (pink) *Penaeus braziliensis* (spotted pink or hopper), *Penaeus aztecus subtilis* (brown) and *Penaeus schmitti* (white) and fin fish.
