THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT

(Cap. 98:04)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 10A OF THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Timber Grant Workers Wages Regulation Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 19th December, 1978. Citation and commencement

2. In this Order — Interpretation.

“timber grant” means any portion of land which is subject to a lease under the Forest Act or any other enactment for the purpose of obtaining timber **therefrom**; Cap. 67:01

“timber grant worker” means any adult person employed mainly or wholly in any capacity in connection with the operation of a timber grant.

3. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the **minimum** rate of wage which shall be paid to a timber grant worker shall be eleven dollars **per day**. Minimum wage payable to a timber grant worker.

(2) Where at the commencement of this Order a timber grant worker is in receipt of a higher rate of wage than that prescribed by paragraph (1), the employer shall continue to pay that worker wages at the higher rate.

4. The Timber Grant Wages Council Wages Regulation Order shall cease to have effect. Effect of the timber grant Wages Council Wages Regulation Order No. 25 of 1961
