## THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT

(Cap. 98:04)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 10A OF THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

- This Order may be cited as the Timber Grant Workers Citation Wages Regulation Order 1978 and shall come into operation on mencement 19th December, 1978.
  - 2. In this Order —

interpretation.

"timber grant" means any portion of land which is subject to a lease under the Forest Act or any other enactment for the purpose of obtaining timber Cap. 67:01 therefrom:

"timber grant worker" means any adult person employed mainly or wholly in any capacity in connection with the operation of a timber grant.

3. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the minimum rate of wage Minimum which shall be paid to a timber grant worker shall be eleven affe to a dollars per day.

- (2) Where at the commencement of this Order a timber grant worker is in receipt of a higher rate of wage than that prescribed by paragraph (1), the employer shall continue to pay that worker wages at the higher rate,
