Major the Honourable William Bain Gray, Master of Arts, Doctor of Philosophy (Edinburgh),

Bachelor of Letters (Oxford), Director of Education;

The Honourable John Sydney Dash, Bachelor of Science in Agriculture, Director of Agriculture;

Colonel William Ernest Horatio Bradburn, Inspector-General of Police;

Major John Cormack Craig, Distinguished Service Order, Member of the Engineering Institute of Canada, Director of Public Works;

Bernard Reader Wood, Esquire, Master of Arts, Diploma in Forestry (Cambridge), Conservator of Forests;

Sydney Howard Bayley, Esquire, Managing Director of the Colonial Transport Department.
