

## CHAPTER 114.

## TRADE DISPUTES (ESSENTIAL SERVICES).

## ORDERS IN COUNCIL

*made under section 3.*

## APPLICATION OF ORDINANCE.

The Trade Disputes (Essential Services) Ordinance shall apply to—

- (1) all departments and services of the Transport and Harbours Department; O. in C. 7 of 1942. (22nd Feb., 1942.)
- (2) the following classes of waterfront workers employed in the port of Georgetown— O. in C. 26 of 1942. (29th May, 1942.)
- winchmen and leading hands;
  - stevedores;
  - sugar packers;
  - dockmen and slingmen; and
  - truckers;
- (3) all persons employed— O. in C. 10 of 1949. (8th Feb., 1949.)
- (a) by the Mayor and Town Council of Georgetown in the House Service Department of the City Engineer's Department;
  - (b) by the Mayor and Town Council of New Amsterdam, in the operation and maintenance of the New Amsterdam Electricity Works, and the New Amsterdam Water Works;
  - (c) by the Sewerage and Water Commissioners;
  - (d) by the Demerara Electric Company, Limited;
  - (e) by any person, in the operation and maintenance of any pumping installation used for drainage purposes;
- (4) all persons employed by the Government of the Colony in any public hospital; O. in C. 2 of 1950. (3rd Jan., 1950.)
- (5) all persons employed by the Board of Control of Atkinson Field in the electricity, water and fire-fighting services; O. in C. 42 of 1950. (28th Oct., 1950.)
- (6) all persons employed by the Mayor and Town Council of Georgetown— O. in C. 30 of 1953. (21st March, 1953.)
- (a) in the Municipal Transport Service;
  - (b) in the operation and maintenance of the Incinerator;
  - (c) in the Cemeteries.
