THE PRESIDENT'S COLLEGE ACT, 1990

(No. 11 of 1990)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER  
BY SECTION 22 OF THE PRESIDENT'S COLLEGE ACT 1990, I  
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cyril Potter College of Education (Board of Governors) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on 1st September, 1993.

2. In this Order "College" means the Cyril Potter College of Education referred to clause 3 (1).

Interpre-  
tation.

3.(1) The provisions of the Act, other than sections 1, 2, 3 (1) and 22, shall *mutatis mutandis* apply in relation to the Educational institution known as the Cyril Potter College of Education and for that purpose shall be read and construed with any necessary modifications, and, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, subject, in particular, for the purpose of such application to the modifications in paragraph (3).

(2) The College shall be administered and maintained by a Board of Governors which shall be a body corporate.

(3) The following are the modifications referred to in paragraph (1) —

for sections 7, 8, 9 and 13 the following sections shall respectively be substituted —

"Aims of  
the  
College.

7. (1) The aims of the College are to provide a place of education, learning and research of a standard required and expected of a teachers' training college is equipping teachers with the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary for the effective delivery of education at the Nursery, Primary and Secondary levels, including Technical Vocational Education.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1) the College shall in particular work in close collaboration with the National Centre for Educational Resource Development and the University of Guyana towards the provision of a progressive course of academic and professional education (with requisite organisation, curriculum, teaching staff and equipment), of a kind and extent suitable for providing and sustaining the quality of teacher training.

Elig-  
ibility:

8. Students who are citizens of Guyana shall be eligible for admission to the College.

9. No student shall be admitted to the College unless he has attained the required age and qualifications as determined by the Minister.

"Vesting of

13. There shall be vested in the Board of Governors all the assets (including rights and interests) of the College, hitherto owned by the State."
