## THE LABOUR ACT

(Cap. 98:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order which amends the Minimum Wages (Employees in Groceries) Order\*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Employees in Groceries) (Amendment) Order 1993, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st November, 1993.

Citation and commencement:

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects —

Amendment of the Principal Order.

- (a) in clause 2
  - (i) by the insertion of the following definition immediately before the definition of "clerk"
    - "'checker' means a person who is employed to certify the accuracy of purchases against bills"; and
  - (ii) by the insertion of the following definition after the definition of "clerk"
    - "driver' means a person who is employeed to drive a motor vehicle in connection with a grocery;"
- (b) by the substitution for the schedule thereto of the schedule hereto.
