ORDER Made Under THE CONSUMPTION TAX ACT (Cap. 80:02)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 4 OF THE CONSUMPTION TAX ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER.

Citation and commencement. 1. This Order, which amends the Consumption Tax Order, may be cited as the Consumption Tax (Amendment) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on 12th February 1995.

Amendment of the Schedule to the Principal Crder. 2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects -
