IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) Order*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) (Amendment) Order 1996, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st March, 1996.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following manner —

*Cap. 98:01 Subsidiary Legislation.

- (a) by the substitution in clause 3 (1) thereof, for the words "nine hundred and sixty eight dollars" of the words "one thousand five hundred and fifty two dollars and fifty cents";
- (b) by the substitution in clause 3 (2) thereof, for the words "twenty-two dollars" and one hundred and seventy-six dollars" of the words "thirty-four dollars and fifty cents" and "two hundred and eighty-one dollars and seventy-five cents".

3. Where immediately before the commencement of this Order a watchman was in receipt of a wage at a rate higher than that prescribed by clause 2 of this Order, the employer shall nevertheless continue to pay to the watchman wages at the higher rate.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order makes provision for the payment of increased wages to watchmen.
