IN EXERCISE OF POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 3 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) Order*, may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) Order 1996 and shall be deemed to have come into operation with effect from 26th January, 1996.

Citation: and Commencement,

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for clause 11 of the following —

Amendment of the Principal Order,

"11. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Order, in relation to the Chairman of the Elections Commission, for such time as the office is held by Mr. Doodnauth Singh, S.C. —

(a) there shall be paid to him —

(i) an allowance of \$9,600.00 per month for the purpose of meeting any expense incurred in respect of the employment of a chauffeur:

- (ii) an entertainment allowance of G\$1,200.00 per month;
- (b) he shall be entitled to have at the expense of the Government
 - (i) a twenty-four hour guard service;
 - (ii) his electricity charges met;
 - (iii) rental of telephone and local and official overseas calls at his residence;
 - (iv) the use of an official car;
 - (v) provision of Transport and Harbours Department passes for riverain travelling.".
