(Cap. 98:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Shirt and Garment Workers) Order 1987*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Shirt and Garment Workers) (Amendment) Order 1996, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st March, 1996.

Citation and Commencement.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the Schedule thereto of the Schedule hereto.
