AND WHEREAS sections 5, 8, 9 and 11 of the Public Corporations Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") was applied to the Company with required modification by notification under section 66 of the Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 5, 8, 9 AND 11 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT, 1988, AS APPLIED TO THE DESIGN AND GRAPHICS LIMITED, BY NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66 OF THAT ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Design and Graphics Limited (Dissolution and Transfer of Assets and Liabilities) Order 1994 and shall come into operation on 31st January, 1994.

2. In this Order —

Inter-
pretation:

- (a) "appointed day" means the day on which this Order comes into operation;
- (b) "Company" means the Design and Graphics Limited, being a company incorporated in Guyana under the Companies act and wholly owned by the State.

3. The Company is hereby dissolved..

4. (1) All the assets and liabilities of the Company (including rights and interests) are, as from the appointed day, transferred from the Company to, and shall vest in, the State.

(2) The assets (including rights and interests) referred to in paragraph (1) shall include —

(a) the immovable property described in the Schedule and

(b) all other assets of the Company including equipment and machinery and other movable property.

(3) All the liabilities of the company are hereby transferred to the State and shall be discharged, by, and be enforceable against, the State as if the said liabilities has been incurred by the State.

(4) The liabilities referred to in paragraph (3) shall include severance pay benefits payable to persons whose employment with the Company is terminated under clause 5:

5. The employment of all the employees employed by the company is hereby terminated as from the appointed day.

6. (1) All deeds, instruments or other documents which were subsisting immediately before the appointed day and relating to any assets or liabilities of the Company hereby transferred to the State, shall be of full force and effect against, or in favour of, the State and be enforceable as fully and effectually as if, instead of the Company, the State had been named therein or had been a part thereto.

(2) All actions or other legal proceedings commenced before the appointed day, for the enforcement of any rights or liabilities which are transferred to the State hereunder, and to which the Company is a party may be continued by or against the State and any such action or other proceedings may be amended accordingly.
