THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988

(No. 21 of 1988)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 8, 9, AND 11 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988, I HERE-BY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Agency for Health Sciences, Education, Environment and Food Policy (Dissolution and Transfer of Assets) Order 1997 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1996.

Citation. and commencement.

2. In this Order "Agency" means the Public Corporation known as the Guyana Agency for Health Sciences, Education, Environment and Food Policy.

Inter-

3. The Agency is hereby dissolved.

Dissolution of the Agency.

Transfer of assets and liabilities of the Agency

- 4. (1) All assets, (including rights and interests) of the Agency as on the day immediately before the commencement of this Order shall with effect from the said day, stand transferred to and vested in the State.
- (2) All the liabilities of the Agency as on the day immediately before the commencement of this Order shall, with effect from the said day, stand transferred to the State and shall be discharged by, and enforceable against the State as if the said liabilities had been incurred by the State.
- (3) The liabilities transferred to the State under paragraph (2) shall include—
 - (a) amounts payable by the Agency to persons employed by the Agency on the day immediately before the commencement of this Order by way of—
 - (i) salary and allowances in respect of any period prior to the said day;
 - (ii) any amount payable in respect of leave or other benefits accrued before the said day;
 - (iii) any amount payable to any such employee by way of pension, gratuity or any other severance benefit; and
 - (b) in the case of any former employee of the Agency who was, as on the day immediately before the commencement of this Order, entitled to receive from the Agency, any pension, the liability to pay such pension.

Termination of employment of employees.

- 5. (1) The employment of all the persons employed by the Agency on the day immediately before the commencement of this Order stood terminated with effect from the said day.
- (2) Nothing in paragraph (1) shall be deemed to prevent the employment of any person referred to in paragraph (1), if other wise qualified for such employment in the public service or in any body corporate owned by the State or the controlling interest in which is vested in the State or any agency on behalf of the State.
