THE LABOUR ACT (Cap. 98:01)

IN THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Citation 1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) and commencement. Order*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) (Amendment) Order

1997, and shall come into operation on 1st July, 1997.

Amendment of the Principal Order. 2.

The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following manner -(a) by the substitution in clause 3 (1) thereof, for the words "one thousand five hundred and fifty-two dollars and fifty cents" of the words "one thousand eight hundred and sixtythree dollars".

> (b) by the substitution in clause 3 (2) thereof, for the words "thirty-four dollars and fifty cents" and "two hundred and eighty-one dollars and seventy-five cents" of the words "forty-two dollars" and "three hundred and thirty-eight dollars".

Employer 3. Where immediately before the commencement of this Order a to continue to pay. Where immediately before the commencement of this Order a watchman is in receipt of a wage at a rate higher than that prescribed by clause 2 of this Order, the employer shall nevertheless continue to pay to the

watchman the wages at the higher rate.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order makes provision for the payment of increased wages to watchmen.
