**THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES
(REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT**

(Cap. 27:11)

**IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 OF THE
CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-**

- Citation.
1. This Order may be cited as the Constitutional Offices
(Holders' Allowances) Order 1999.
- Allowances
for judges.
2. Notwithstanding anything in the Principal Order, with
effect from 1st March, 1999 there shall be paid -
- (i) to every Puisne Judge subsistence allowance at the
rate of two thousand dollars per day subject to the
conditions of payment from time to time applying to
officers in the public service;
 - (ii) in respect of any period for which he is not provided
by the Government with a furnished residence a
house allowance at the rate of twenty-five thousand
dollars per month shall be paid to the Chancellor,
the Chief Justice, every Justice of Appeal and every
Puisne Judge.
