THE ROADS ACT (Cap. 51:01)

- 13 EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 (2) OF THE ROADS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—
- 1. This Order, which amends the Schedule to the Roads Act, Citation may be cited as the Declaration of Public Roads (Miscellaneous Roads) Order 1982.
- 2. The Schedule to the Principal Act is hereby amended as Amendment of the Schedule to the Principal
 - (a) by the insertion at the end of item 2 (POTARO) of Part A of the Schedule of the following —

"The road known as Sherima-Allsopp Point Road leading from Sherima on the West Bank of the Essequibo River to its intersection with the Bartica-Potaro Road at Allsopp Point.

The road known as the Teperu Road leading from its intersection with the Bartica-Potaro Road at the Teperu junction to Teperu on the East Bank of the Mazaruni River.

The road known as the Itabali-Puruni Road leading from Itabali on the West Bank of the Mazaruni River to a point on the East Bank of the Puruni River opposite Peter's Mine.";

(b) by the insertion after item 6 (NORTH-WEST DISTRICT) of Part A of the Schedule of the following —:

"7. HINTERLAND.

That portion within Essequibo of the road known as the Kuruduni-Suribanna Road leading from the Kuruduni junction at its intersection with the Mabura Hill Road to Suribanna on the East Bank of the Essequibo River,": and

(c) by the insertion after item 5 (EAST COAST) of Part B of the Schedule of the following:—

"6. HINTERLAND.

The road known as the Mabura Hill Road situate at the West Bank of the Demerara River commencing from Wismar on the West Bank of the Demerara River to Mabura Hill.

That portion within Demerara of the road known as the Kuruduni Suribanna road leading from the Kuruduni junction at its intersection with the Mabura Hill road to Suribanna on the East Bank of the Essequibo River.
