## THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT (Chapter 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Offices for the Public Service Ministry) Order 1982.
- 2. The buildings and erections constructed or proposed to be constructed on the land described in the Schedule hereunder, is hereby declared to be a public work.
- 3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining-such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part thereof for the public work aforesaid.
