IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT. I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Ministry of Foreign Affairs) Order 1982.
