THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT (Cap. 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, 1 HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—
