## ORDER

THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT
(Chapter 62:05)
WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Guyana National Archives) Order 1980^, made on the 25th day of March, 1980, the land described in the Schedule to that Order was declared to be a public work in accordance with section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WHEREAS, by the said Order the Chief Works Officer together with his agents, servants or workmen, was authorised under section 4 of the Act to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the Acquisition of the whole or a part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer and a plan of the land and building to be acquired, were laid before the Minister.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of the said section 6 , it is hereby declared that the land, together with the building and erections thereon, described in the Schedule to this Order, is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Guyana National Archives) Order 1980.

## SCHEDULE

That parcel of land known as Sublot ' $D$ ' being part of Sublot ' $A$ ' of the east portion of Lot 28, Main \& Holmes Streets, situate in the South Cummingsburg Ward, in the City of Georgetown, in the County of Demerara, in the Republic of Guyana, together with the building and erections thereon, surveyed and defined on a plan by Hardat Dharamdial, Sworn Land Surveyor, datcd 24th April, 1980, and recorded on the 20th June, 1980 at the Department of Lands and Surveys, Georgetown as Plan No. 18961.

The boundaries of Sublot ' $D$ ' commence at an Iron Plate marked S.S.R.I. in concrete at the north eastern corner of the said Sublot ' $D$ ' and proceed thence $N$ $75^{\circ} 03^{\prime} 10^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ (tr.) for a distance of 102.07 feet, thence S $14^{\circ} 56^{\prime} 50^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ (tr.) for a distance of 44,74 feet, thence $S 75^{\circ} 03^{\prime} 10^{\prime \prime} E$ (tr.) for a distance of 102.07 feet, thence $\mathrm{N} 14^{\circ} 56^{\circ} 50^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}(\mathrm{tr}$ ) ) for a distance 44.74 feet to the point of commencement.

The said parcel of land shown, bordered red on a plan contains an area of 0.1048 of an acre.
