A.D. 1918. An Ordinance to amend the Weights and Measures Ordinance, 1851.

[18th May, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Court of Policy thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Weights and Measures Ordinance, 1851, Amendment Ordinance, 1918, and shall be read and construed as one with the Weights and Measures Ordinance, 1851, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and with any amending Ordinance.

Amendment of Sub-sec. 1

2. Sub-section (1) of section twelve of the Principal Ordinance shall be construed and have effect as if the words" Member of the of sec. 12, shall be constitued and have choosed of sec. 12, Ord. 2 of 1851. Police Force not below the rank of Corporal "were inserted after the words "Justice of the Peace" in the first line thereof.
