## ORDINANCE No. 16 OF 1914.

An Ordinance to amend the Ordinances relating to the Boerasirie Water Scheme.

[17th July, 1914.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Court of Policy thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Boerasirie Ordinances Amendment Ordinance, 1914, and shall be read and construed as one with the Boerasirie Ordinance, 1889, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and with any Ordinance amending the same and with the Boerasirie Loan Ordinance, 1902.

Short title and

2. For the purpose of regulating the supply and distribution of water from the Boerasirie the Commissioners shall have power to order any proprietor to remove any weir, sluice, lock, koker or dam and in case of refusal to comply or failure within a reasonable time to comply, may enter upon such plantation for the purpose of removing the same and performing any other work hereby authorized and shall have power to maintain and control or to construct, maintain and control all such canals, water-ways or other works through and plantation as may be expedient for the conveyance of water to any other plantation or plantations and may assess upon the plantation or plantations so supplied or upon all the plantations deriving benefit from the said works or upon the whole area included in the Principal Ordinance the expenses of such construction, maintenance and control and any further sum which the Commissioners may in any case decide to be a fair compensation to the proprietor or proprietors of the plantation or plantations through which the water is so conveyed and may prescribe the manner in which such supply shall be furnished and the means of taking and receiving the same.

General Powers and Duties of Commissioners.

3. Every person who wilfully damages any dam, trench, outfall, koker or sluice in the possession or under the control of the Commissioners without lawful excuse shall be guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction, and, being convicted thereof, shall be liable to a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars and not exceeding two hundred and forty dollars, or to imprisonment, with or without hard labour, for any term not exceeding three months.

Penalty for damage.

The Commissioners or the proprietor of any plantation may prosecute any charge under this section.

Assessment of damage if no conviction.

- 4.—(1) In any case where damage has occurred to any dam, trench, outfall, koker, or sluice in the possession or under the control of the Commissioners the Commissioners may assess upon and recover from any plantation immediately adjoining the property so damaged a sum in compensation for such damage including the loss of any water occasioned thereby. Provided always that where the proprietor of the said plantation satisfies the Commissioners that some person has been prosecuted to conviction for the said damage he shall not be liable to be so assessed.
- (2) The provisions of section nineteen of the Principal Ordinance as regards the authority of the Governor-in-Council shall apply to any such assessment.

Parate execution not to issue against Crown land.

5. Parate or summary execution shall not be issued under the Principal Ordinance, or under the Boerasirie Loan Ordinance, 1902, against any Crown land.

Schedule,

6. The Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be the Schedule to the Principal Ordinauce and the sum in Columns III. and IV. set opposite the names of the Plantations in Column I. shall be deemed to be the sums referred to in sections twenty-three and twenty-four of the Principal Ordinance and the Schedule hereto shall also be deemed to be the Schedule to the Boerasirie Loan Ordinance, 1902, and the sums in Column V. set opposite the names of the plantations in Column I. shall be deemed to be the sums referred to in section two of the latter Ordinance and the acreage of the plantations shall be deemed for the purposes of both Ordinances to be that set out in Column II. and all references to a Schedule in the aforesaid Ordinance shall be taken and read as referring to the Schedule hereto.

Enforcement of Order in Council. Amendment of Ord. 7 of 1889, s. 17. 7. On failure by the Commissioners to carry out any Order of the Governor-in-Council under section seventeen of the Principal Ordinance within such period as shall be prescribed by the said Order or by any subsequent Order, the Governor-in-Council may direct the Colonial Civil Engineer to carry out the said Order and the Colonial Civil Engineer may thereupon enter upon any lands in the possession or control of the Commissioners or otherwise subject to the Principal Ordinance, for such purpose, and the Governor-in-Council may direct the Commissioners to pay the expenses of the carrying out of the said Order by assessment on the plantations or on such plantations as he may direct.

Works to be constructed by Commissioners.

- 8. Section eight, sub-section (1) of the Principal Ordinance shall be read and construed as if the following sub-head (e) were added at the end thereof.
  - "(e) Any works which the Governor-in-Council may direct to be constructed and maintained as being necessary works in addition to or in substitution for any of the aforesaid works."

Repeal, No. 22 of 1911. 9. The Boerasirie Ordinances Amendment Ordinance, 1911, is hereby repealed.
