

CHAPTER 205.

PENSIONS INCREASE.

[No. XXVIII of 1924.]

[12th July, 1924.]

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions Increase Ordinance.

Increase of pension to certain public officers ;

2. Every public officer who retired from the public service of the colony prior to the first day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, and who is in receipt of a pension under the provisions of any Ordinance shall be entitled, when the pension does not exceed one hundred pounds, to an increased rate of seven and one half per centum, and when it exceeds one hundred pounds but does not exceed three hundred pounds to an increased rate of five per centum.

to certain widows and orphans.

Chapter 207.

3. Every widow and orphan, and every widow or orphan, who is in receipt of a pension under the provisions of any Ordinance other than the Widows and Orphans Pensions Ordinance, except any widow and orphan, and any widow or orphan, whose pension has been computed on contributions made by a public officer on any permanent increase of salary as from the first day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, shall be entitled, when the pension does not exceed one hundred pounds to an increased rate of seven and one half per centum, and when it exceeds one hundred pounds but does not exceed three hundred pounds to an increased rate of five per centum.
