WHEREAS it is enacted by section twenty-nine of the Customs Ordinance, Chapter 33, that the Governor may be proclamation prohibit the importation of arms, ammunition, gunpowder or any other goods;

And whereas it is expedient that the importation of "Tear Gas" should be prohibited:

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the authority by the above recited enactment in me vested I do hereby prohibit the importation into the Colony of "Tear Gas."
