THE BAUXITE (PRODUCTION LEVY) ACT 1974

(No. 29 of 1974)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 14 OF THE BAUXITE (PRODUCTION LEVY) ACT 1974, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations which amend the Bauxite (Restriction on Exportation) Regulations 1974* may be cited as the Bauxite (Restriction on Exportation) (Amendment) Regulations 1974 and shall come into operation forthwith

2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the word “take” appearing in the definition of the word “export” of the words “or attempt to take.”

3. Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulations substituted therefor —

“4(1) It shall be lawful for the Comptroller, or the Commissioner, or any member of the Police Force, or any other person authorised in writing in that behalf by the Minister —

- (a) to enter, or board, and inspect any premises or vessel, as the case may be;
- (b) to give directions of a general or special character to any person,

with a view to securing compliance with these Regulations.

- (2) The power to give directions pursuant to paragraph (1) (b) shall extend to the giving to the bauxite producer, or the person for the time being in charge of a vessel, or any other person having an interest in the shipment of the bauxite, of directions —
 - (a) prohibiting the taking of any action for the purpose of effecting the loading of any vessel with bauxite;
 - (b) as to the unloading from any vessel of bauxite, the exportation of which is prohibited by these Regulations.

4. Regulation 6 of the Principal Regulation is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the word "fails" of the words "to comply with any directions given under regulation 4 or".
