THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT

(Chapter 47:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS —

- 1. These Regulations, which amend the Post Office (Overtime) Regulations, * may be cited as the Post Office (Overtime) (Amendment) Regulations 1975 and shall be deemed to come into force on 1st January, 1973.
