THE ROADS ACT

(Chapter 51:01)

UNDER SECTION 25 OF THE ROADS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS

Citatolon 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Roads (Corenmencement tyne) Regulations, 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st August, 1975.

Interpreba-

2. (1) In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires —

"toll station" means the erection established and maintained by the Chief Works Officer —

- (i) in lot No. 9 commonly known as Lewis Manor, Corentyne, at a point on the Corentyne Road approximately 1,250 feet east of the point of intersection of the centre lines of that road and the side line dam between Lot No. 7 and the said Lot No. 9 (hereinafter referred to as "Toll Station No. 1"); or
- (ii) in Plantation Hogstye, Corentyne, at a point on the Corentyne Road, approximately 875 feet east of the point of intersection of the centre lines of that road and that portion of the side line dam between Plantation Salton and Plantation Hogstye, south of the said road (hereinafter referred to as "Toll Station No. 2"); or
- (iii) in Lot No. 62 Corentyne, at a point on the Corentyne Road, approximately 490 feet north of the point of intersection of the centre lines of that road and the side line dam between Lot No. 62 and Lot No. 63, commonly known as Benab (hereinafter referred to as "Toll Station No. 3"),

for the purpose of the collection of the charges prescribed by Regulation 3:

"vehicle" does not include a bicycle or any vehicle being used in the service of the State and which is so designated by markings duly placed thereon.

- (2) In these Regulations, the expressions motor vehicle, goods vehicle, motor bus, motor cycle and motor lorry shall be construed in conformity with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act but do not include a reference to an invalid carriage Cap. 51:02 within the meaning of that Act.
- 3. (1) There shall be paid by the driver of any vehicle referred Rate of toll. to in the first column of the schedule the amount respectively specified in the second, third and fourth columns thereof against that reference for the passage of such vehicle beyond the toll station mentioned in the respective column.
- (2) The payment required by paragraph (1) shall be made at the respective toll station and a receipt shall be issued to the driver of the vehicle upon such payment.
- Regulation 2(1) of the Roads Regulations* is hereby Amendment to Regulaamended by the substitution for the definition of "vehicle" of tion. the following definition —

""vehicle" does not include a bicycle, or any vehicle being used in the service of the State and which is so designated by markings duly placed thereon.'.
