REGISTRATION (ELECTIONS COMMISSION) REGULATIONS
1964

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the British Guiana (Registration) Order 1964, the Governor in his discretion has made the following regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Registration (Elections Commission) Regulations 1964. Citation.

2. There shall be an Elections Commission consisting of three members, being a chairman and two other members, who shall exercise, in accordance with such further regulations as may be made under section 2 of the British Guiana (Registration) Order 1964, direction and supervision over the registration of persons possessing the qualifications prescribed in section 3 of that Order. Constitution of Elections Commission.

3. The following persons are hereby appointed to be the members of the Elections Commission — Appointments.
 - (a) Geoffrey William Young Hucks, Esquire, O.B.E., to be the chairman;
 - (b) George James Fisher, Esquire and Keith Reed Whitnall, Esquire to be the other two members.

4. Each member of the Elections Commission shall, before performing any of the functions of his office, take and subscribe the official oath as prescribed by the Promissory Oaths Ordinance. Oaths. (Cap. 70)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These regulations, made by the Governor in his discretion under section 2 of the British Guiana (Registration) Order 1964, appoint an Elections Commission consisting of a chairman and two other members to supervise the registration of persons under further regulations to be made under that Order.
