REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE BRITISH GUIANA (REGISTRATION) ORDER, 1964.

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (REGISTRATION) ORDER, 1964, THE GOVERNOR IN HIS DISCRETION HAS MADE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registration (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 1964, and shall be construed and read with the Registration Regulations, 1964*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations. and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 52 thereof of the following new regulation —

“52A. Any person who sells or attempts to sell, or purchases or attempts to purchase, or pledges or attempts to pledge, or receives by way of pledge in any manner whatsoever an identity paper of an elector or any document or thing purporting to be an identity paper of an elector shall be guilty of an offence.”
