THE MOTOR VEHICLE AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 51:02)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 103 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Regulations, Cap. 51:02 Subsidiary Legislation, may be cited as the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations 1989. Citation

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the substitution for regulation 204A of the following regulation — Amendment of the Principal Regulations

"Tariff of fares to be exhibited in motor bus or hire car" 204A. (1) No person shall drive or operate a motor bus or hire car on a road unless a fare-table showing the tariff of fares fixed by the Prescribed Authority with respect to the route on which the motor bus or hire car is plying, is clearly exhibited in the motor bus or hire car, as the case may be, on the near upper corner of the front windscreen away from the steering wheel.

(2) The said fare-table shall be in such form as the Prescribed Authority may specify and shall be capable of being read from the inside of the vehicle.

(3) A person who drives or operates a motor bus or hire car shall not charge a fare for any stage of a journey in excess of that fixed by the Prescribed Authority.

(4) Every passenger shall pay the fare fixed by the Prescribed Authority for the whole journey undertaken by him.
